AREA31 Officially Appointed as Exclusive Partner of Eutelsat OneWeb

Pepok, August 20, 2025 - AREA31, a leading Indonesian provider of data center and digital infrastructure services, has officially announced a 10-year strategic partnership with Eutelsat OneWeb, a global provider of low Earth orbit (LEO) satellite internet services. The signing ceremony took place at the AREA31 Datacenter in Cimanggis, Depok, and was witnessed by approximately 25 national media outlets, marking a historic milestone for both organizations.

In addition to the signing, AREA31 hosted a media tour of its Cimanggis data center, offering firsthand access to the infrastructure that will serve as the Point-of-Presence (PoP) for OneWeb's LEO satellite services in Indonesia. This collaboration will be further strengthened by the development of a satellite teleport facility in Ciruas, Serang, Banten. LEO satellite technology plays a critical role in

Indonesia's connectivity landscape, given the country's vast archipelago of over 17,000 islands, many of which are difficult to reach with traditional cable or fiber-optic networks. LEO satellites offer fast, stable, and low-latency internet access, even in remote and underserved regions.

Michael Alifen, President Director of AREA31, emphasized in his remarks, "We believe internet access is no longer a luxury, it's a fundamental necessity." AREA31 is committed to building inclusive digital infrastructure that reaches all layers of Indonesian society. The partnership with Eutelsat OneWeb represents a strategic move to deliver equitable connectivity, particularly to 3T regions (Frontier, Outermost, and Disadvantaged areas).

Echoing this sentiment, Fabio Mando, Chief Operations

Officer of Eutelsat OneWeb, highlighted Indonesia's strategic importance: "With AREA31's support,

we can deliver reliable, high-quality connectivity to regions that have long been underserved. This is part of our global mission to connect everyone, everywhere."

The event also underscored AREA31's role as a regional hub for digital connectivity. With its teleport facility in Serang and PoP in Cimanggis, AREA31 is not only reinforcing Indonesia's national infrastructure but also paving the way for satellite internet distribution across Southeast Asia and Northern Australia.

This partnership is expected to generate significant benefits across multiple sectors, including online education, remote healthcare, e-commerce, digital governance, and disaster preparedness.



The presence of LEO satellites will help bridge the digital divide that has long challenged Indonesia's development.

With growing market demand, increasingly proinvestment regulations, and accelerating digitalization in education, healthcare, and government, AREA31 is strategically positioned to meet the rising need for connectivity in 3T regions and beyond.

From Humble Dreams to Boundless Reality:

The Journey of Prasetiyo Haryono

Prasetiyo Haryono, fondly known as Tiyo, was born in Bandung on June 16, 1983, into an academic family. His father was a lecturer at the Bandung Institute of Technology (ITB), while his mother taught physical education. Though he once aspired to become a chemistry researcher, his father's guidance steered him toward electrical engineering. Armed with his father's legacy of books and an insatiable thirst for learning, Tiyo pursued his studies at Universitas Jenderal Achmad Yani and began his career as a technician and engineer.

His professional journey began with power system projects and Bandung Jakarta. eventually taking him to Papua with PT Freeport Indonesia. There, he managed telecommunications and power systems both above and below ground. He also contributed to critical projects with Telkom, Telkomsel. and

Indosat, including

efforts

restore systems during Jakarta's flood recovery.

These experiences laid a solid foundation for Tiyo's expertise in electrical and telecommunications engineering.

In 2019, Tiyo joined DTP as a Solar Power Plant (PLTS) technician. He was immediately entrusted with five Super Wifi sites in Lebak, Banten, and later participated in a major project in East Nusa Tenggara (NTT), covering over 100 sites. His skill in designing solar and UPS systems proved instrumental in delivering connectivity to areas still beyond the reach of electricity.

Over time, Tiyo was appointed to lead the Mechanical Engineering (ME) team in Serang and eventually promoted to Supervisor. He emphasized the importance of an electrical engineering background in understanding technical work, along with the value of teamwork and mutual support. Despite transitioning from urban to rural environments, Tiyo remained enthusiastic and confident that every challenge has a solution.

He sees DTP's rapid growth, especially with the advent of Low Earth Orbit (LEO) satellite technology





as a game-changer for connectivity. Proud to be part of this transformation, Tiyo views it as a tremendous opportunity for young people to contribute meaningfully.

Tiyo encourages the younger generation to embrace honesty, discipline, and wisdom in facing challenges. He believes that motivation and curiosity are the keys to continuous growth. His personal motto is simple yet powerful: "Discipline and keep learning." He still recalls the words of his lecturer, Mr. Sugi Hartono, who once told him, "If you want to keep moving forward, don't give up. If you haven't succeeded yet, repeat until you do." That message continues to fuel his spirit to this day.

Tiyo's story is not just a career narrative, it's a testament to perseverance, adaptability, and lifelong learning. From technician to supervisor, he proves that with family support, personal drive, and a collaborative work environment, anyone can grow

and make a real impact. Amid rapid technological advancement, Tiyo remains grounded in the values of integrity and discipline. His journey inspires the next generation to pursue not only professional success but also strong character and meaningful contributions to others.

Mr. Uge Sutisna, Head of RW 04, expressed his heartfelt gratitude and appreciation to AREA31:


